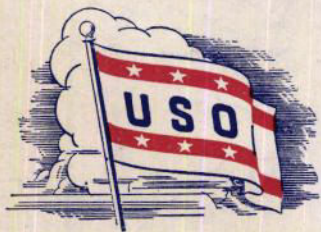

Dearest Judith
 at present I'm at the
 U.S.O. in Spartanburg. There
 isn't much activity at
 all any of the fine U.S.O.'s in
 this town. at the Jewish one,
 they are having a free supper
 so I will be there then.
 I let you no later how
 the supper was.

The reason for writing
 now is because I forgot
 to mention in my previous
 letter that the candy didn't
 melt. The weather has
 been cool for the last two
 days. I wish it remains
 like this for the duration
 of my stay in South Carolina

My second reason for writing was because you I don't want you to worry your little head about that address Dave gave me. ~~Charlotte~~ ^{Charlotte} is so far away and out of the camp limits. Besides I don't think I would go out of my way for any girl except you dear.

It's 8 o'clock now and I'm back in the barrack. After supper at the Jewish U.S.O we went for a walk. It started raining so we decided to go home.

at the U.S.O I saw a few women whose husbands are stationed at this camp. They was one couple - (unmarried) who come from Washington Heights. The fellow lived on 157th on the Riverside Drive. He is a few years older than I am, therefore I didn't



no him.

Marty and I went
bowling. There weren't any
civilian at the recreation
center except the pin
boys and manager. The whole
town of Spartanburg was
full of soldiers.

I was just informed
that there were about 7
letters for me today. I
missed mail call as I
went to town early. The
mail clerk doesn't give
the letters to any one
else. I therefore have to
wait until tomorrow.

I can't imagine from
who I got so many letters

It's bad you can't be here now so
we could go swimming together. We did
have a nice time the last time we
went.

That's all the news I can think of.
For now. So I close with love and kisses.
