made a mistake by  
only thanking your  
parents for the lovely  
cake. We while your  
mother's name was  
on the return address

My mother informed me that I received notice for payment of Income Tax. Did you get your notice?

Dearest tomorrow will be my toughest day that I will spend at Camp Croft. I don't know my duties yet except that I'll get up at 4:00 local.

When we get back in our barracks tomorrow night I will have to clean my rifle and then we have a floor show.

I may not be able to write  
you a letter. If not I drop you  
a postcard and Saturday  
when I will have more time  
I write you a nice letter.

This evening I saw the  
picture Bataan! It was  
another war picture just like  
Wake Island only worse.

Honey I do didn't feel  
bad because you are  
going to the V.S.O. In fact I  
think it's a good idea. It  
keeps you occupied and it's  
not a crime to  
meet some fellows and talk  
to someone else besides  
your girlfriends. If by  
attending the V.S.O. you  
have the opportunity to  
see how other fellows  
act. Then you can be  
more sure you love me.
