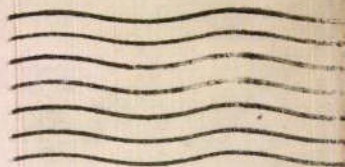

Dearest Judy,

I have about an hour before lights go out so I decided to start on tomorrow's letter.

I'm mailing you a photograph postcard of the main entrance of Camp Croft. On the right you can see the guest house. On the left you can observe the Service Club.

In my opinion it would be a good idea to house yourself at the guest house. There are a few rules that in which one is a guest can only rent a room for three days unless they are not crowded when you may stay longer. It would be much more convenient for me to see you. I could easier meet you at the Service Club.

There is a restaurant at the Service Club where you can eat. It only cost 75¢ cent a night at the guest house. Another good feature is that many women stay at the guest house and you can ~~me~~ get acquainted very easily. Therefore during the day you won't be alone. It would be very convenient for me to ~~to~~ escort you home. It takes me about 15 minutes with the bus to get to the Service Club or guest house. It is necessary to notify the club at the guest house at least three weeks in advance if you intend to rent a room there.

I think it would be advisable to ~~reserve~~ ^{make} the reservations for the room beginning with Sunday or Monday night and stay here as long as possible. Then you can stay with a private family.



I also think that when you plan to come down you arrange to be here on Saturday and stay until the following Sunday. In that way we can spend two Saturdays and Sunday together.
