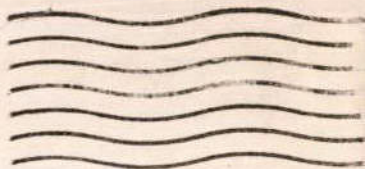

My Dearest Judith,

Just as I said, "last night I didn't do a darn thing. We just walked around Main St then dropped into the main V.S. in town. Stayed a few minutes and departed for home.

Today I when swimming in the afternoon. We decided to eat at the Service Club and while I'm here I figured I write you.

Tonight Marty and I are going to see "Action In the North Atlantic". I think it will be an exciting and interesting picture.

This morning I answered all the letters I received for the week.

We had an excellent lunch today consisting of roast beef, mashed potatoes, beans, gravy, orangeade and chocolate ice cream plus bread and butter. That's the type of meals I really enjoy.

The weather isn't very warm today. It's like a summer day in New York. Remember the hot weather you had in New York. At that time we had our hottest weather. I therefore don't think that the climate will affect you much down here unless we have an especially hot weather.



Good to hear that you are an "Air Raid Warden" but do you have time for it, you seem to be so busy.

Do you still work late at your office on Wednesday and Thursday evenings?

Tomorrow I have another ~~K.P.~~ detail. I go on K.P. I may not have time to write much so you can expect a short letter. The reason why we get one detail after another is because my barrack is the only group in my company.

We expect some fellows
