I starting on tomorrow's letter now because I have a few items I would like to get off my chest before departing for bed.

You must have had a feeling of telling somebody what on your mind and yet you were confused because you didn't know to whom you wanted to tell it to.

I saw the picture "Stage Door Canteen" and the picture left me with an especially lonesome

feeling for you. It made
me think of ^{how} nice it would be
to spent a full day with
you again. I do hope it
will be soon.

Coming back from the
theatre I saw a many fellows
from the 28th Battalion on
guard duty. After speaking to
them I was informed that
they completed there basic
training and next week
they are getting a furlough.

I came back to my barrack
a little confused as to whether
its planned that I receive a
leave or not. I spoke to my
sergeant about it and
got a little information
from him.

Friday
at the above place the
lights went out and I didn't
realize how quickly ~~it was~~
the time went by.



I didn't even have time to write Good night darling.

Now getting back to what the sergeant said; there is a new order by which all men when completing basic training they are to receive a few days' leave". Doesn't that sound good? But you never can tell what will happen in this army the next day. Therefore I would like to have you come down to see me.

When I receive my furlough, if I get it during the later part of August, we can have that my more days together. I don't necessary

have to receive a furlough or 2

I may get my leave at my next camp. It sounds good and I'll be looking forward to spent a few days in New York with you again.

I was also informed that I'm going to get an extra week of training. My last week of training will be a review of the work I covered during my 13th weeks. That means that if I should get the furlough I may be home for my birthday. I didn't write my mother about it yet because it's not definite.

Just had mail call and besides receiving a letter from you I got a package from my sister containing home made cookies and candy.
