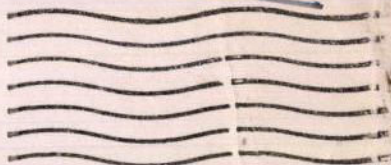

Monday

My sweetest Judy,

I'm sorry I forgot to tell you in my letter yesterday that I'm going to try and call you up Wednesday evening. My brother wrote me saying that Bobby and him will also be at your home Wednesday evening. I hope I'll be able to get you when everybody is present. There is one problem I'm up against, Wednesday as I mentioned before is problem night. I place the call around 5 to 5:30 o'clock and hope I receive it by 7 o'clock. I'll tell the telephone operator that I would like the call to be placed at around 6:45 o'clock.

I want to call you to make sure you received my air mail letter, speak to my mother and find out how my brother made out plus I want to hear your voice and those three little words that thrill my heart.

I didn't receive a letter from you yesterday or today but I'll be looking forward to mail call tomorrow when I'll expect two or three letters from you.

Darling it will be much better if I get my furlough and spend your vacation with you in New York. I'll be able to be with you all day. We will be able to do things that would be impossible down here.

I went to see a stage show tonight sponsored by Camels'. It was a good show with professional stars.
