My Dearest Judy,

Received the delicious, tasty home made cookies today. There were so good, it only took five minutes to empty the tin can. Did you made them? ^{Thanks for sending them to me}

How are you enjoying your both of July week-end? Having hot weather? Is the beach crowded?

Today I feel very lazy so I'm lying down on my bunk. We have a work sheet ~~to do~~ to finish by tomorrow so I'll have to get started on it soon.

It will take about three hours.

Dear, the fulough is almost definite except for one thing. If I should be up for shipment as soon as I finish training then I won't be able to get my leave at this Camp. I then suppose I'll receive

it at my next camp. Its very unlikely to that I'll be up for shipment to another camp because it takes a few days to make out my record as to work and tests. My furlough will be for 5 days plus traveling time. at the end of my fourteenth week. Unless I write you different from now until the day you have to refund the tickets the above statement will be as correct as possible.

I welcome. I told you but Ben + inbaum and his girl friend ^{now} sent there best regards to you. I wrote him likewise.

Julie U mail letter only took one week to reach me. Considering its very good time.

In my letter yesterday I remember writing sissy I meant silly. kindly correct it for me.
