Wednesday

To the Sweetest and Smellest Girl.

Today I feel I more than earned my days' pay. I took a shower and shave and now resting in my bunk. Its 8:30 o'clock at the boys just came back from there hike.

Dearest, I kept thinking over what I wrote you about the dance that made you question me on it over the phone. While I can't remember the exact wording I ~~do~~ didn't write any thing to make you feel bad maybe I didn't word it correctly or you might have mis understood me when reading it.

Whick ever way it may be there is one thing I want

you to clearly understand.

When I write you I love you, I miss you or any other place that I may use to express to you how deeply in love I am with you, I mean it with all my heart. It isn't a saying that I'm only writing to make you feel good but I feel it and I'm expressing it to you.

I was also thinking that maybe you feel that I don't want you to come down to visit me. If you do it's definitely wrong. Darling I would like to see you as much as possible. I hope you surprise me and come down here. If you could make the trip yourself it would be swell.

Considering that if I get my furlough I would like to be with you all day.

 I'm in a state of confusion.
 As far as details go I
 sure I won't be getting
 any after next week because
 next week the 2nd platoon
 finishes there four weeks
 of basic so they will start
 to get the detail jobs.

I received a card from
 the post office saying they
 are holding some article
 that requires 3 cents postage.
 The post office is at the main
 gate and it closes at 7's clock
 so I was unable to get it.
 Tomorrow I hope I have
 time to get it. It even may
 be a letter that somebody
