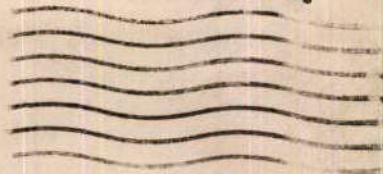

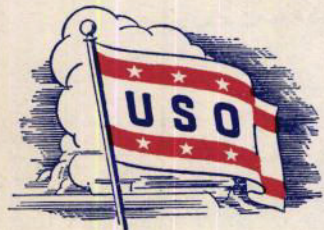
July 25, 1943

Last night I was at the U.S.O. when back to camp around 12 o'clock and after a long sleep we (nuddes)

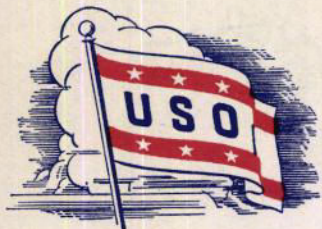
decided to come back here where we could write letters in a nice environment.
