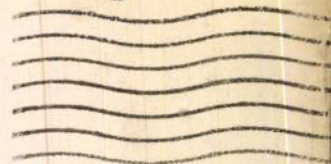

to wait until tomorrow.

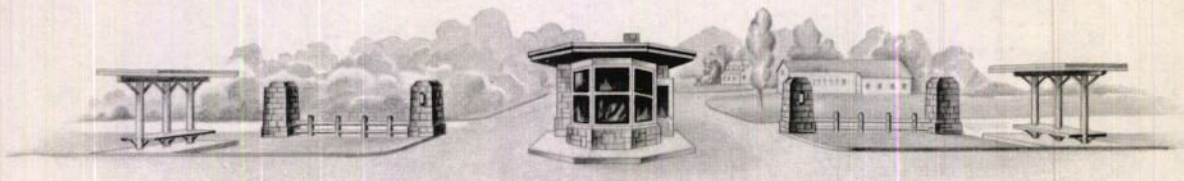
I completely forgot
