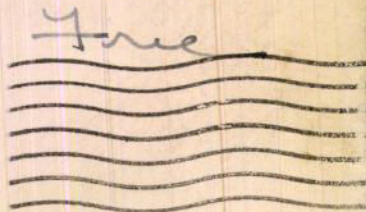

to complete that sentence.

It's now 9:00 clock and
I'm at the Service Club
to meet and I went to the
early B.D. movie and saw
"Two Tickets To London" We
decided to come up here
where we could write and
I could get the best, and
delicious milk shakes I
eventasted. Whenever
I come up here I have
at least two and some

sometimes 3. They use about 2
6 scoops of ice cream and
a small amount of milk.
Does it taste good.

Received your roll of
film today. Thanks for sending
me another roll. Darling,
I can't ~~take~~ use all the
films to take pictures of
myself, what would the
other people think, may go
into town tomorrow and
use up the roll of film.

Sorry I forget to listen
to the program your father
was on Thursday evening.
How was he?

as far as being a
veteran dear I feel that it
won't be for quite some
time to come. You see
a soldier isn't considered
a veteran until he is in
combat.



It may be hot down here
but now that I've been
here for awhile I'm seem

myself under the trees, away
from the sun as much as
possible.

be on the field for two weeks
than back to camp for
any another week and I've
then complete my training here.

be getting 17 weeks of
training after all.
