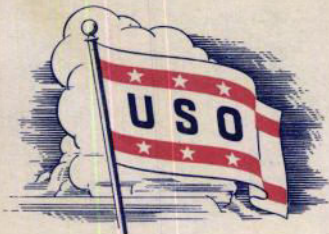

since I'm in the Army I feel  
more or less like a free  
man because we got

we brought a few items

Went into the military
