My Darling Judy

Today I received your first letter since I left home.

You must have received my previous letters informing you about my chances of coming home again soon.

Yesterday just as I was about to write you excellent news we had a air raid alert. So darling I'll write the good news now even though I believe I'll be seeing you or you will be hearing from me by telephone that I'm on my way home.

I signed the furlough papers yesterday and I expect to get my orders tomorrow or Friday. Regardless

If when I get my orders if I go to Camp Meade I will receive a furlough.

I earnest I could have called you up today but I prefer to wait until I get my orders as I expect it any day. And you when I call you I'll be able to tell you when I'll be home.

I know you are going to feel good to read this letter sweetheart if you didn't hear from until now.

I can just picture myself reading this letter to you as there is a good possibility of being home on Saturday.
