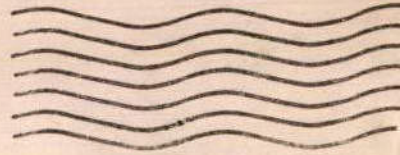

September 29, 1943

Dearest Judy
after leaving you yesterday I
said good-bye to my mother on
34th street than I rushed down
to Penn station. as I turned around
after receiving my baggage warack
bag I was my mother standing
in front of me. so I said goodbye
again and went to the train.

Arrived in Phila at 2:30. Luch
and went until I got a bus and
arrived at my sister's house it
was 3:45. Luch.

Sergie is a real devil
keeping my sister busy. Allen
looks cute.

Jack and my sister drove
me into Camden, then I took the
bus to Phila. made the 7:50
train and ~~took~~ the train took
me to Odenton. there a bus was
waiting and in ten minutes later
I was in camp. arrived in camp.

at 10:45 o'clock. The city of Odenton²
is located between Baltimore
and Washington. I was lucky
because not every train
stops at Odenton and the city
is only a few miles from camp.

After having some chow he
went to the barracks to get a
night's sleep.

Up bright and early again,
then after chow I had a
complete physical examination.
Then back to the barracks to
get my equipment to be
moved to the barracks I am
at present.

Spent the afternoon having
a clothing check and then
loitering around.

Was going to go to the PX
to buy some ink and stationary
but a notice just came out
saying that the whole company
is restricted to company area.

At present I'm in the day
room which is a small room
with one ping pong table, a
table for writing, few chairs and
a piano and reading material.



the fellows leave come and leave here every day. There is a group of fellows that are ~~even~~ expected to leave late tonight. The boys remain about a week so before I'll realize it I'll be out of here.

This isn't a P O E unit only prepares a soldier to go there or any combat unit in the state. I'll be getting a lot of extra clothing.

Having seen any of my class from Camp Croft and I doubt if I will because this is such a large camp.

I didn't ask for a pass for the Jewish holidays because they are having services right in camp.

This letter won't go out until tomorrow so you should receive it on Friday. If you

answer me the same day
I hope to receive your letter
on Saturday.

Doubt if I'll be able
to meet you in Baltimore
or any other place because
of restrictions, but if any thing
should develop I'll telephone
you.

Darling, I hope you don't
think this is a short letter because
it's only four papers because
if you notice you will
see that my handwriting was
small.

That's all for today dear.
Closing with all my love.
