So far we haven't had any schedule for the day so we just eat, sleep and sit around all day but tonight my whole unit has guard duty. From what I've been hearing the nearby city is a nice place. If you are writing me I mail during and I'm here long enough I will receive some mail from you. At least I keep hoping so every day.

The weather here isn't as cold in the evening as it was at my other camp. This camp has many advantages, that the other camp didn't have. For one we can take hot showers instead of ice cold one.
