My Darling Judy,

Today, as I wrote you yesterday I was supposed to go to town today, but for some reason the passes were cancelled but now I'm very glad of that because today was my happiest day since coming overseas. I finally received mail from you.

Last night we had our first mail call and I then received a letter from my mother, which made me feel good, even if the letter was dated Oct 3.

Today we had mail call again, this time I received three letters from you, two from my brother, and the other from my mother. The letters are far from being in order as I shall show you.

Your letters darling were the following

no 113 dated Oct 3 - no 115 dated Oct 5 and the latest which was a V mail dated Oct 13, no 123 my brother's letters dated Oct 3 and Oct 5 and the latest letter of them all from my mother dated 19, Oct 19.

NOTE - address me as you see my return address on the envelope.

So you can see that the letters don't come in order and it's to be expected. Maybe tomorrow I'll receive more mail and I believe I will at least, my mail has found its home, for a while any way and I'm glad of that.

I'll have to save all my letters now so when I can put them in order of date and re-read them they will make better sense. you probably has the same trouble with my mail, so you must no what I'm talking about.

now, as to your letter, 12/3 dated Oct 13.

"I said you said wouldn't use U mail any more" I don't no why you say that, yet I hope you continue to use U mail and type write it because it's clear and compact which makes it easier for me to save.

Glad to hear that you were over my mothers house to have supper. From my mothers letter it she enjoyed herself and I hope you did also.

Happy to hear that you sent me a package of something. Regardless of what it contains it is appreciated. maybe I'll receive the packages soon. As you no I can't drop over to the PX every night and buy what I want.

Havent received a letter mentioning about the nail polish set I sent you that made but I guess it will be in a letter that I get soon. I hope you did receive the set.

Very nice of you to save the snapshots that I sent home. when I return we can place them in our family album.

I wrote Aaron a letter giving my new address so maybe I'll hear from him one of these days.

Sweetheart, you probably no how good I feel now that I've received letters from you. It must have been awhile before you got my first overseas letter.

Sorry to hear about your grandfather having an operation. Hope that his condition has improved greatly and he's completely well soon.

Don't continue to write that old Co, and an address. That was my unit at Meade, the post office my unit but I'm in the 1st regiment that's happen to be overseas.

When I get to my permanent outfit I'll give you my company and regiment address well deserved, I'll love you, praying I hear from you tomorrow with arms, love and a kiss for every soldier and WAC.
