Now that you have my present address I'll probably will be receiving all your V-mail within ten days after you mail it.

Last night my buddy Harry (aka a Washington Heights fellow) and I had some cookies and cocoa that you and my mother send me. The cocoa is the same as the one has in its C Ration cans. The Red Cross doesn't serve coffee and doughnuts, cake or ice cream anymore so it sure felt good to have the cookies and cocoa before going retiring for the evening. Darling it was swell of you to send me the packages.

Believe I'll go to the movies this evening and see 'Thank you for your service' the picture sounds familiar and I think that I might have seen it before.

Didn't have mail call today yet as its early, but I'm hoping for more letters from you.

Keep that beautiful skin up dear and keep smiling. I'll be right with you when you get about all, I mailed you the Swain's eyes picture. Love and best wishes
