yesterday I wrote you telling you I was depressed cause I haven't heard from you for about a week, but now I feel much better and I see you have the same troubles as days go by without getting a letter from me, but honey, I write you every day except when I'm traveling.

The cigarette lighter sent by your father's organization, also arrived today. It definitely will be useful, and I would have to worry about matches any more. I'll write a letter of thanks, ok?

Your letters were dated March 30th, 31st and April 2nd.

There must be a complete mix up with the gifts I sent home, if Bobby received Helen's gift. You see, I had the Red Cross box the articles, instructing the wrapper, how and in what package I wanted each article placed. I intended to have your mother's gift with your sister's in the same package.

I honestly don't know if ²
your mother's package is with
Daddy, but I don't think so as
the pins are similar. Possible
by now your mother received
a package containing a small
very small pin and the sea
shell ornament. I'm I correct?

No I guess you weren't
kidding about the packages
you sent me and if you want
more requests I'm going to give
it to you. Want it now. OK
I'm requesting chocolate candy.
I'll request the above again in a
U mail letter, in case you don't
want to show this letter.

Glad to hear that my
mother invited you up for the
second night of Pass over. Yes,
honey, I remember last year at that
time plus all the other times we
were together. That's about all I
keep dreaming of and the hopes of
continuing those pleasant days
in the future with you.

In my letter written
yesterday, I now think that I
contradicted my self if so you will
have to excuse it mainly because
of not hearing from you for a
week.

you probably heard that my mother's allotment has been stopped, but not until today did my personnel section receive word of it so I was only drawing my usual pay. Now in May I'll be getting the back money and I'll be paid \$34.75 month from then on instead of my present \$12.75. The other day I wrote home for money because now I'll be able to spend it.

Tomorrow I'm going on another five day pass to the rest center, like I did when I bought all the gifts for home. Now I'm short of money and won't be able to do it, but I hope the money order from home comes quickly.

Even though I'm on a rest now I like going on the five day pass to the rest center because the routine is different. Are you confused? The rest center is a large building in a city, and every outfit sends a few men every five days. Now do you clearly understand?

The worst part is that I won't be getting your mail but I'll certainly have something to look forward to when I return back ~~home~~ here

Since I wrote you a
~~was~~ air mail yesterday, and
 this one will be the same
 tomorrow. I better write a mail
 in case it travels quicker. I
 also intend sending you another
 cablegram which this time I
 hope you receive.

Almost time for chow
 darling so now I can close
 feeling much more cheerful
 and hoping that all is well.
