Had my evening chow meal at them to settle down to write you.

My mail consisted of a wide variety, from my folks at least one letter from each of the fellows, which includes Julie, Aaron Frank and Hy. A very surprising letter from one of the boys from the East side that I haven't heard from in over four months. I doubt if you remember him anyway his name is Normy. Remember? No, I didn't think you would. I'm I forgetting, no, that I also received two mail from you dated April 3rd and 5th, your large Easter poster which I loved and a package containing two rolls of film and an other nice candy letter. In short honey thanks for all the above things.

Can't understand but the camera didn't arrive yet. Dearest, I know of two more rolls of film on the way besides.

the three rolls I already have, therefore, it isn't necessary to buy for me any more film until one I get the camera and second till I take a few pictures and see how they look in the final stage. I'll be able to snap forty pictures, that's enough for awhile.

I didn't see the show "This is the Army" because the show doesn't open until tomorrow. In this city it's now scheduled for. I probably will have the opportunity in the near future to see the show as it will be playing for five weeks in the same theatre.

My sister claims that she didn't receive her pin, so there must have been a complete mix up with the package I sent home.
