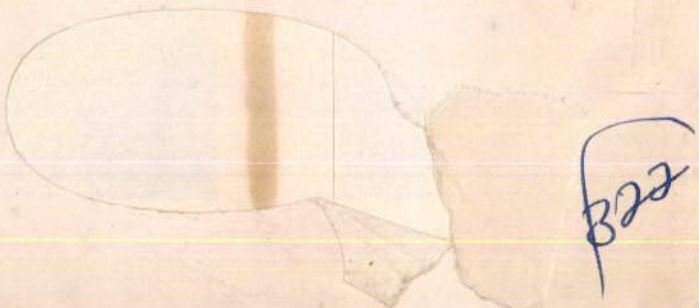

Regret that I was unable to write you yesterday due to the same old reason, which by now you must know.

Today was a profitable day in that I received four small letters from you. Until today about four days passed without receiving any letters from you, therefore you can visualize how pleased I was.

Your letters were dated May 17, 18, & 19th 1944 instead of a pen in your 4th mail letters as the writing is finer it's perfectly okay as it's good and correct.

I delighted to hear that you were able to locate another place at Long Beach and you are pleased with the room. your own entrance is nice and operable - be handy for the rest of the girls.

A letter from Sam Schaefer states that he believes that he might be sent overseas shortly and that Stanley (the Polish fellow) is at a P.O.E. therefore he probably will be over here or possible when Judith is now-stationed.

It seems to be going fine from over here and I hope that all is well with you dear and family. Closing with kisses of love and a kiss for every part.
