The first <sup>call</sup> mail from this country was today and I received your air mail letter of Aug 5<sup>th</sup> with the kiss of your lips sealed on the back of the envelope. Also your thoughtful birthday cablegram arrived. The telegram did arrive later than regular but that is to be expected due to the situation I was in. Thanks for sending it darling.

You mention in your letter the picture you saw <sup>seen</sup> "It Happened Tomorrow" and I saw it also around the same time and thought it was enjoyable.

It's difficult to imagine unless you actually see it, how the French people feel when they first see American troops entering their surroundings. A lot of them say they would give long years for us so that France can once again rise. Even during the night at the roar of motors and tanks the people come out of their houses in their war workshirts to welcome us. They <sup>crowds go</sup> go wild with excitement and chats occur in the smallest village to the larger cities.

Besides the French bread given to us by the civilians I haven't had any <sup>French</sup> good bread, because we can't obtain it. The bread is delicious.

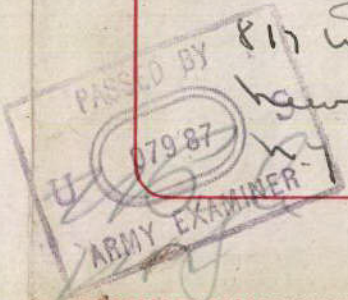

V-Mail Service provides the most expeditious dispatch and reduces the weight of mail to and from personnel of our Armed Forces outside the continental United States. When addressed to points where micro-film equipment is operated, a miniature photographic negative of the message will be made and sent by the most expeditious transportation available for reproduction and delivery. The original message will be destroyed after the reproduction has been delivered. Messages addressed to or from points where micro-film equipment is not operated will be transmitted in their original form by the most expeditious means available.
