

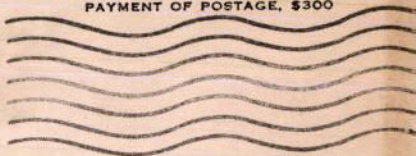

I thank you very much for the letter that I must have seen one of your last I mail letters, I imagine the letter was dated Sept 20th. Better a lot better than none. The letter was mainly giving me a scolding, as at that time you haven't heard from me in three weeks. I'd say that was when I made the trip to Southern France. Yes I was over optimistic in predicting it would be only about a week that you wouldn't hear from me. The next time some thing like that happens I'll be sure to extend the time a few weeks so you won't worry.

Get the paid tonight. Tomorrow I'm going to the post office to buy some more air mail envelopes and also to get a small money order to send you for a anniversary gift for your parents. I'll write the details in tomorrow's letter dearest.

Trying it easy this evening instead of going over to the theatre. It's actually to cold for me to go outside walking to the theatre when I can remain here and stay warm.
