I thought I mentioned it in my letter in one batch of negatives that I mailed you that I didn't want you to send me the negatives, as I had prints developed for those negatives.

Didn't feel like going to the movies this evening. Instead we went to the snack bar for some coffee and cake and then departed to come here where I am now the ARC writing room.

I even received a package from Mom today which I was very glad to get, because for some reason I seem to miss those packages

Received my weekly Ration card today but since the Rx was so crowded I decided to wait a day or two before I get my rations.
