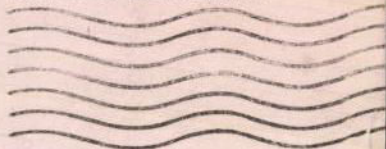

Hello my Darling,

Sunday
March 4, 1945

If you already received my letter of yesterday the first to bring you probably ^{the} answers to read in this letter is the report of the dance that was held for us last night. The dance was very unsuccessful for the simple reason, without exaggeration up until 9:30. Look, there were fifty servicemen to one girl and then six more girls entered which reduced the figures to about twenty fellows to one girl. I managed to dance a few dances, therefore I didn't have such a terrible time. My mixture of being able to speak just a little French and German was a aid. Some of the fellows just a few but that's enough that behaved terrible which scared the girls to death and you couldn't blame the girls since they were so few. Darling I couldn't but help thinking of how I would so much prefer to be dancing with you.

Didn't enquire about getting a pass to visit Home today because under the circumstances I doubt if I could receive one, but if I remain here another few days I'll probably get another chance.
