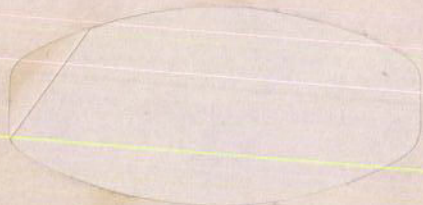

March 8, 1945

Today I received your special letter of Feb 25th which happens to be written on Sunday. I imagine since you just returned from your week end vacation you didn't have the fancy stationery to use on Saturday.

You need not worry about me writing any phrases in French dear, because I would need a dictionary in front of me to look up the spelling.

There isn't any set ruling on when after how many months is the Army supposed to send me home on a furlough.. I don't intend to return until it's all over, over here and the news both from this front and the Eastern front, is bright and hopeful it's still a question though of exactly, how much longer.

That's all the news for this evening dear I love you very much, take good care of yourself
