Sunday
March 12, 1945

I received two V mail letters from you dated Feb 12th and 13th plus your splendid Valentine box of chocolates which did hit the spot. The package came through my former mail clerk, which he told me yesterday that he had a package for me. If you don't understand clear, you will when you receive yesterday's letter.

It's a lovely day today. The weather is warm and the sun is very strong. I'm sitting outdoors while I'm writing this letter. Reminds me of last year when I was near Cassino and then around March I used to sit outside the shelter house I was occupying.

Since I'm now able to write you daily you probably realize that I'm not too busy even though I am somewhere in Germany.
