I decided the typewriter needed a rest so I'm writing this letter. Please, don't say its about time.

Received three more letters from you. Two U mail of which one most have been lost in the mail since it is dated Feb 21st and the other one dated May 17th. Also received a special air mail letter from you honey dated May 12th.

I imagine its true what General Eisenhower said about those in the North African campaign won't be going to the Pacific, Savvy honey out that doesn't apply to me for the simple reason that I wasn't in any of the North African campaigns.

True, I landed in Africa
but I was at a replacement
depot plus the fact that the
campaign in Africa ended before
I landed there.

Was very surprised to read
in the Stars and Stripes, the
naming of four divisions that are
held back home, then going to
the Pacific. Since it was in the
S+S it must have been
released to the newspapers back
home. Since there doesn't seem
to be any security or censorship,
perhaps one of these days you
will hear something about
my division around the same
time that I'll know what is
in store for us.
