Army May Be Sent to Pacific Stars and Stripes Says

PARIS, Monday, June 11 (A)-The Army newspaper Stars and Stripes said today the United States Fifteenth Army "is expected to cease operations shortly" and that it might be transferred to the Pacific.

The newspaper, in a dispatch from Wiesbaden, Germany, quoting unidentified "officials," said that the reassignment of Lieut. Gen. Leonard T. Gerow's forces would follow "official announcement of the occupation zones of the Twelfth, Army Group."

Relief of the Fifteenth will "make it available for a possible shift to the Pacific," the article

added. f

"The fact that the Third and g Seventh Army Headquarters have 0 been designated for the army of occupation does not mean that troops now in those armies are d necessarily destined for occupae tion," the newspaper said, declaro ing that the redeployment situation was bringing about an almost complete revampment of per-The United States Ninth Army

is halting operations June 15 and the First Army already is headed for the Pacific.
