Today I saw the snapshots that I took yesterday and the day before that. Yes sir honey the pictures are already ~~dev~~ developed but the prints were still wet therefore you will have to wait just one more day. The pictures didnt come out to good but thats because of my inexperience with the camera. I was informed of my errors and on the next roll of film I beleive Ill do better. For one thing I didnt quite expose the shot long enough. Because of that all the pictures came out dark. The picture I had taken of myself while typeing you a letter darling came out fair except that it would have been must better as I now realize if I had adjusted the camera just a little differently. I used an 8 lens with a one second time exposer. It would have been better to use a 4/5 lens at a 10 second time. The reason for it is because to whole the camera for one second without moving it difficult while a faster time with a larger lens opening would have been just as good. Now that Im being to learn a little about different speeds and lens openings I find it more interesting.
