My Darling,

I imagine that you will be pleased with this letter since you probable already glanced at the enclosed snapshots. Correct. Considering that the pictures were the first that I've taken on the new camera I consider the snapshots satisfactory. I believe that if you took the negatives in to be developed into prints you would get a better set of prints than I have for the simple reason that this man who developed the pictures only has one type of paper and since the pictures are dark a different type of paper is needed. The picture that I consider I took the best I had a few copies made. On the first roll of film I had seven pictures taken of myself alone. The other five shots I took of the other fellows and I gave them their pictures. I'll enclose all seven pictures in this letter darling along with the negatives. I'll send Mom one picture, the one that I had a few copies made. If Mom would like to have any of the other pictures that I'm sending than I'll appreciate if you either give Mom the negative so she can have a copy made or you have the copies made.
