Thus far today my typewriter has be operating like a charmand I hope it continues until I finish this letter. The first slip up in the above ~~pa~~ sentence was my own fault.

For over two weeks no men have gone on pass but today a few more men went on pass and this time to Nancy in France. The reason I beleive that men havent been going to Paris is because of the high rate of VD that is reported coming from Paris. Its really a shame especially for those fellows that would like to see the sights in Paris.

Prehaps you were able to put your finger on me when I was in Augsberg but honey I dont think that you can do it anymore unless you have a very large scale map of Germany ~~kaxxxx~~ because Wasseralfinger isnt a very large town. You shouldnt have much difficulty locating the city of Aalan which is about three miles from where I am. I guess that is close enough.

Received your swell air mail letter of June 20th today which took only six days. I certainly hope that the rapid speed of your letters continue honey as this way you dont seem so very far away.

I now have three more rolls of film and as soon as I can snap some interesting pictures Ill do so as

I have plenty of film now. Today's it is a rainy day therefore I'll have to wait for nicer weather. I'm still waiting for the roll of film that I'm having developed to be returned to me. I'm anxious to see how the pictures came out.
