Hello My Darling,

Today I received your air mail letter dated exactly one week ago. It onex x of the longest letters in quite some time.

I cant understand why you are under the impress ion that Im not receiving your letters cause your mail has been fairly regular and I always mention in my letter to you what letters I received from you dearest.

Yes, hon those are German people in the background of the picture that you ^{have} of my company at retreat formation. Is their any special reason for you asking me that question ?

Its true what Howie wrote Syl, about the division breaking up just as I informed you dearest but just in the last hour I heard some strange rumor which might change the category of the outfit. All of the latest shipments have been cancelled, and three men that left just today to go to the division MPs are returning to the company. This isnt just a rumor but a fact and its not only aplying to my company but Ive spoken to a few fellows from another company in the division and they told me the same thing. Therefore something new may be instore for the unit.

Ive read in yesterdays Stars and Stripes ,the complete list of all the divisions in the ETO and what is going to happen to them. I imagine that you also read about it since it was a War Department statement. Forty two divisions are suppose to be back in the States by the end of this year ,and eight more divisions were named as permanent occupation of Germany. The other eighteen divisions are suppose to remain here until shipping space was available to return them to the States sometime next year and the 12th aeromored division was included in the letter list. The list naturally is only tentative and I anticape a change in the status of my outfit since all shipments now are frozen. I dont think that you have to worry about me dear as I now feel sure that I wont be heading to the Pacific .

Cant understand what gave Mike the impression that I was living in a former concentracting camp unless it was due to one of my errors in writing as its definitely not true nor was it ever. W We are billeted in a schoolhouse ,while it isnt as nice as when we stayed in apartment houses its much better than what Mike thought I was quartered .
