Im now writing you from my new outfit. We arrived here about five o'clock just in time for chow. After that we went to take a shower since we were very dirty & passing over the dusty roads. Very fortunately Im quartered in a building as before we reached my company we stopped off at the other companies and I saw the men filling into tents. I was amazed as I certainly figured that for an occupational division they would have decent quarters. My company has been in its present position for five days and the rumor is that we are going to move again in a few days. The name of the town is Kruchburg and it about thirty miles from my former position. As soon as I am oriented a little more on my new outfit Ill write you about it darling.

Luckily just before I left my old company we had mail call and I received two letters from you dearest, dated July 13th and 15th.

The very first question that we were asked in the company by the company commander was, "do we wish to remain here or go to an active theatre of operations?" Naturally everybody said that they would prefer to stay here.

Sorry that the typewriter is not functioning properly but possible its due to the trip. As usual perhaps after a nights rest it will work better.
