Their wasnt much of any activity today. In the morning we had a little close order drill and exercising and thats about all. During the afternoon I went for a short swim in the creek that is about a five minute walk from our barracks. The water is head deep in this small area where my company goes swimming. After supper this evening I went to take another shower and here I am now writing to you.

Naturally I didnt receive any mail honey nor did I expect any. Im thinking if possible to return to my former company Saturday to see the fellow and perhaps the mail clerk will have a few letters for me.

The fellows in this company are okay of what little I know of them. On the average most of them are older than the fellows that were in my former company. Thats because most of the low point men have also left this outfit for redeployment and the real old timers have more than 85 points and already departed for home.

My 60 captain seems to be a regular fellow. He just joined this company and before he was a

a company commander in the 12th armored division.

Tommmorrow we are scheduled to see the Jack Benny show which is now touring the ETO .

The meals have inproved recently not only in my present company but I beleive that its all over the 7th Army. Now we are beginning to get much more fresh meat which is much better then the stew and hash.
