My Dearest Judy,

Im now writing to you from our new location, and in a few words its paradice to our former position. We arrived here around two o clock in the afternoon. and then I straightened out my clothing and bedding. For the first time since overseas I placed all my clothing in a dresser and OD in the closet. Yes sir dear its as nice as all that.

There are eight other men in the three story house besides myself. We all have a comfortable bed to sleep on and plenty of room. Each floor of the house is an apartment in itself having two bedrooms, a living room and a kitchen. There isnt more than two men to one furnished bedroom. The lonely thing that we are missing is a radio and we have been promised one, as our CO is trying to get a radio for each and every house. That just about tells you of my new living quarters and we been told that this will be our permanent position until we depart for the States.

Im in the town of Hainstadt which is about twnety miles from the city of Frankfurt on the Main. The Main river flows through the edge of this town. We ~~also~~ have an outdoor mess hall using what

was once an beer garden. When it rains I dont know what we are going to do as their isnt room inside the beer house to feed the company.

The weather was fair today and thank goodness that it did not rain.

Our company street is also nice similar to a small town back home as ⁱⁿ the street their are trees and on most of the houses the green leaves are clinging.

All in all I couldnt ask for anything better over here but its far from a subitute from being away from you sweetheart.
