Today being an national holiday we also had the day off and I took advantage of it by relaxing and this afternoon I went to a near by town to see if I could buy a handbag for Mom. I did meet a man that manufactures handbags but he didn't have any in stock to sell me, therefore he is going to make one for me on the style that I desire from seeing a few samples. I don't know how good the pocketbook will be when finished but I do hope that it is satisfactory. I'm going to keep the fountain pen myself and send Mom the handbag. The bag will not be finished until the end of the week.

The men with over seventy points under the old computing left today to report to the 7th armored division which is slated to return home to States by the end of the month. Now I have eight more points added on to my score for a total of 76 points. I feel that the points will be lowered at least five more ~~times~~ before the year is ended therefore I have hopes that I might be a civilian before News Years. Time will tell. Their will be so many things that ^{we} will want to do together when I first return home darling that now I don't know from where we will start but the main thing is that I'll be able to wrap my arms around you and be with you physically and not only mentally as it's been during these ~~long~~ ^{long} past, almost two years.

No more rumors today therefore you can sleep soundly, and pleasant dreams. I love you with all my heart and sweet heart, I will forever and forever
