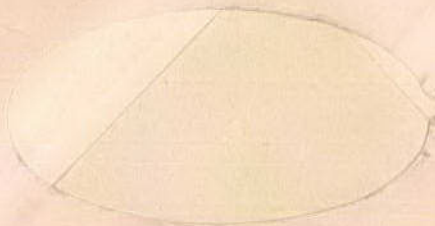
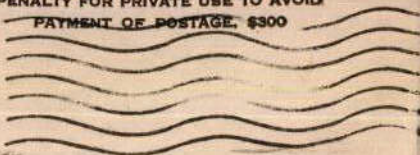

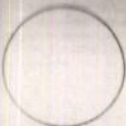

Hello My Darling,

Monday
Sept 20th 1945

The report today is that a stamp of our records on air on the way to the States by way of airplane, so when we arrive in the States each man will be sent to his nearest separation center. I'm a little pessimistic that I will be shipped directly to an separation center cause the War Relocation Department just announced a few days ago that starting October 1st, men with 70 and over points will be discharged, but so long as I'm back in the States I'll feel relieved. The strong rumor is that all men in my camp will go directly to an separation center. I received the maximum eight points from US to US day which now gives me a total of 76 points.

Late tonight or early tomorrow morning the official shipping notice is supposed to come down from high head quarters also the separation number of each man on the company roster.

Instead of going to the movies this evening I'm reading the novel "Cock and High Heaven" which is an interesting story on the love of two people but their love is complicated due to their different religious beliefs, traditions, and strongly opposed to each other by heart.
