Hello My Darling,

Back in Paris again, this time for three nights, we arrived here around 6:30, this evening, was bed and ate. Now I'm at one of the ARC clubs, where a dance is being held, and later, the three other fellows I'm with and myself intend going to the late G.D. theatre to see the movie "Over 21". This time we intend to spend as little money in Paris as possible because if we continue at the rate we been spending we all would shortly be flat broke. Mainly we are here cause of the comfortable billets

and we don't want to do any  
more of the tour. I have familiarized  
myself with the subway system  
now and am able to get  
around just as if I was traveling  
from one place to another with in  
the New York subways.

The hotel that we are at, is the  
same as the first time we came  
here, we quartered there upon  
our request because its a  
small hotel, and no waiting  
for tables in order to eat,

I hope when I return to  
camp starting, I found a few letters  
from you, I constantly miss not  
hearing from you, after a fairly  
steady flow of your letters  
receiving me for two years.
