My Beloved Judy,

Returned from Paris this afternoon glad to find your undated & mail letter but I imagine that is was written around Oct 10th since you related that you received my & mail letters of Oct 1st, 2nd and 3rd.

Not back in camp one hour and the fellows put in for another pass starting tomorrow and good until Monday. The majority of men from my battery are living in Paris hotels, all the fellows are doing the same as we are.

I'm again writing you this letter from the camp & RC hut, and even here there is a marked change, why a few weeks ago it was difficult to obtain a seat for writing and now the place is comparatively empty.

There is suppose to be a quota each day of men going on pass

but it seems that every one that
puts in for one gets it.

We hitch-hiked back from Paris
and luckily we got a ride in a
command car all the way to the
entrance of our camp. It was one
of the most comfortable rides I
ever had in the army.

Last night darling we went to
the amusement park the same
familiar name as the one at
Loney Island, "Luna Park," went on
a few of the rides, and one that
I've never been on before nor
do I feel like repeating it I don't
know the name of the ride but
I'll draw it for you as you have
seen it often.
