The only new rumor is that all the 70 pointers in this camp we suppose to be out of here by November 24th. We had an one hour orientation on the redeployment system, and mainly about my own unit, and just where they stand in the big picture, after we leave here we will go to a staging area camp, where we will remain from seven to ten days, repeating the same processing that we underwent at camp St. Louis. Taking all this into consideration, I'll be kind of glad if I'm home.
