Right now my unit is prepared to move out to the port, as we have completed our processing.

We had to make out custom declaration, duffle and hand tags, and each of us were informed as to what camp we would go to after our arrival in the States. I'll be headed to "Fort Dix" where I'll remain for an average of three days, then leave the camp as a civilian.

So now, it's just a matter of sitting back and waiting until we get the port call to proceed to the docks to embark on a waiting ship.

I would like to travel on one ²
of the Navy ships that's due at
La Haine in a week, cause then
the trip would take only five
days, but so long as I get on
something that floats, I'll be
satisfied.

Saw a variety show at the
Red Cross last night that was
amusing. Today it's a rainy
unpleasant day, but it doesn't
make the slightest difference
since there isn't anything to
do but hope that we don't stay
here too long.
